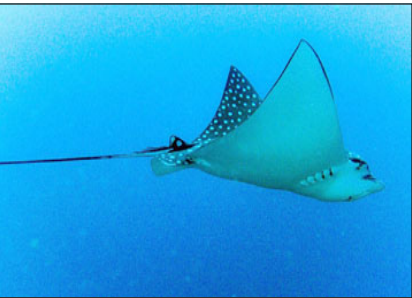

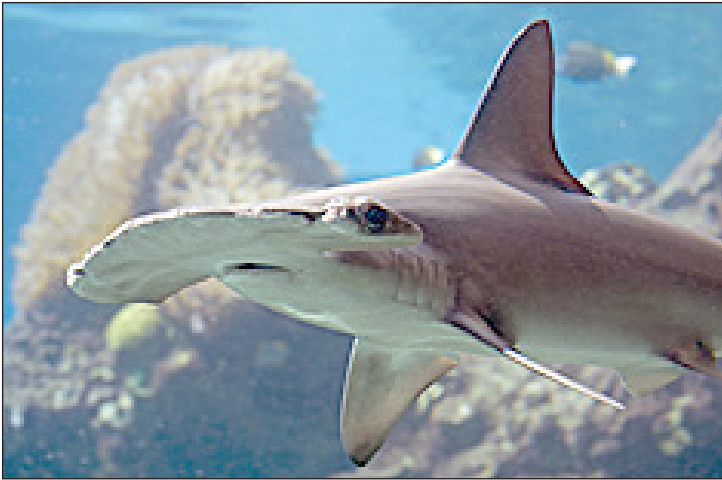
Keynote Speaker:
